

Drainlaying information sheet No.11

Audit: Below ground stormwater

Phase 1

- Have documents been sighted which show building consent has been granted?
- Are the materials used fit for their intended purpose?
- Is the discharge capacity adequate for the catchment area?
- Where required has provision been made for a drain installed in unstable/water charged ground?
- Does the excavation comply with the WorkSafe Good Practice guidelines?
- Where required is a reflux valve installed?
- Where required does the drain have overflow provision?
- Is the drain connected to the correct connection(s)?
- Does the bedding installation comply?
- Does the bedding material comply?
- Does the drain have the correct gradient?
- Did the drain pass the correct test? (e.g. testing listed in E1/VM1 8.0)

Phase 2

- Where required have inspection openings been installed?
- Have the required concrete supports for drainage fittings been installed?
- If a retention system is installed, has a surcharge outlet point been provided?
- Does the installation comply with the proximity to other services?
- Does the backfill material comply?
- Does the drain have the minimum cover?
- Is the drain constructed in an appropriate size?

The compliance documentation and audit items on this checklist are intended as a guide only and are not an exhaustive list.

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- Have appropriate covers been used on inspection risers?
- Is the design of the drain to an acceptable standard?
- If the drain has been installed in an easement, is the installation compliant with the requirements of the easement?
- Where required has the soak pit been appropriately sized?
- Where required has the soak pit been appropriately constructed?
- Where required have the sump(s) been appropriately sized?
- Where required are the sump(s) correctly constructed?

Does the installation comply with the minimum industry standards and legislation?
