


CERTIFYING PLUMBER TO CERTIFYING DRAINLAYER APPLICATION FORM



You may be eligible for certifying drainlayer registration if you are currently licensed as a certifying plumber and have four years of full-time drainlaying experience. **You will need to complete the application form, submit all required evidence, and pay the application fee before your application can be reviewed.**



EVIDENCE CHECKLIST



Things to consider when gathering your evidence:

- each piece of evidence should be saved in a separate PDF file and clearly named
- providing a good range of quality evidence can make the assessment process easier and quicker to complete.
- where specified your evidence needs to be a certified copy. A certified copy is a photocopy of an original document that has been officially declared to be true and correct by a lawyer, Justice of the Peace (JP), or Court Registrar.
- complete each checklist to make sure that you submit all the required evidence.

REQUIRED EVIDENCE CHECKLIST

You need to provide evidence to show that you have the full-time work experience and knowledge required of a certifying drainlayer.

This table outlines the types of evidence you need to submit to show your drainlaying knowledge and experience.

<input type="checkbox"/> A Ministry of Justice (MOJ) criminal record check dated within the past month
<input type="checkbox"/> Reference letters showing that you have the required full-time experience in your trade. Your reference letters need to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• be dated, and signed by your referee• cover four years of full-time restricted drainlaying work experience, with exact dates (dd/mm/yyyy) of employment• list the specific drainlaying work that you carried out• verify that you have completed the work carried out in any photo or video evidence that you submit.

The Board may contact your referee if they have questions. Your reference letter needs to include the phone number or email address of your referee.

You will need to show that you completed the work carried out in these by being in the photo/video or by a statement from your supervisor.• Certified copies of upskilling, training, or CPD that you have completed such as supplier training, JDPE welding, machinery operator.• Job cards – verified by your supervisor.• Certified copies of invoices, tax records, contracts, design plans, Council / Territorial Authority plans, quotes, consent/permits, etc.• Territorial Authority site inspection paperwork or testimonials from Council inspectors.
